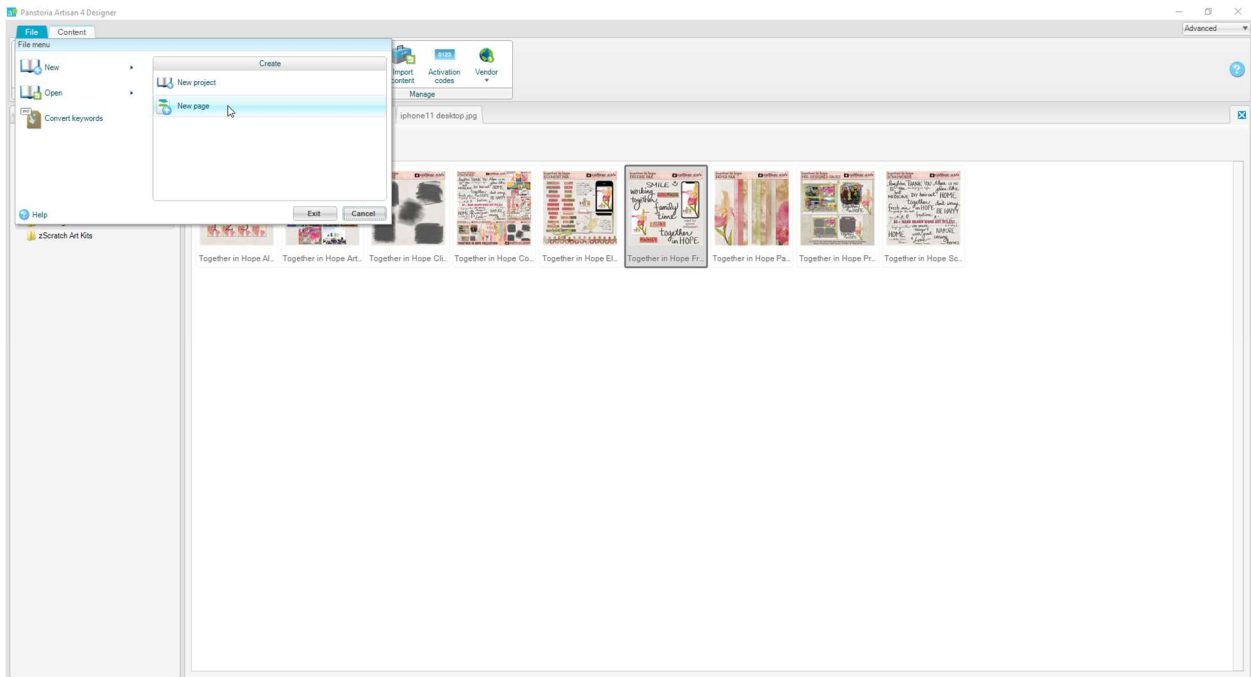
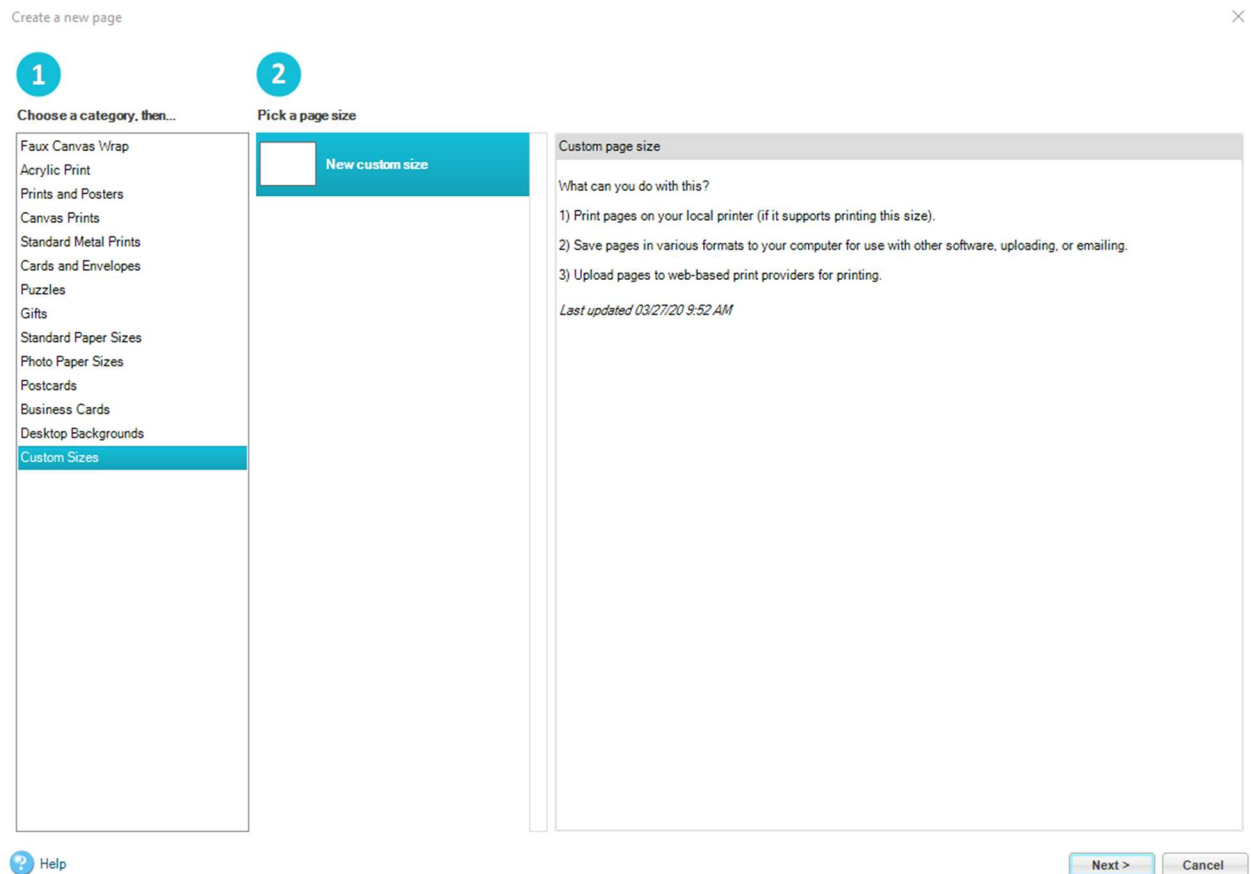


To use the "Together in Hope" phone wallpaper on your smart phone (using Artisan 4):

1. File -> New page



2. Select Custom Sizes -> New custom size -> Click Next



3. Enter width and height of your phone screen. Example below is for the iPhone 11 -> Save

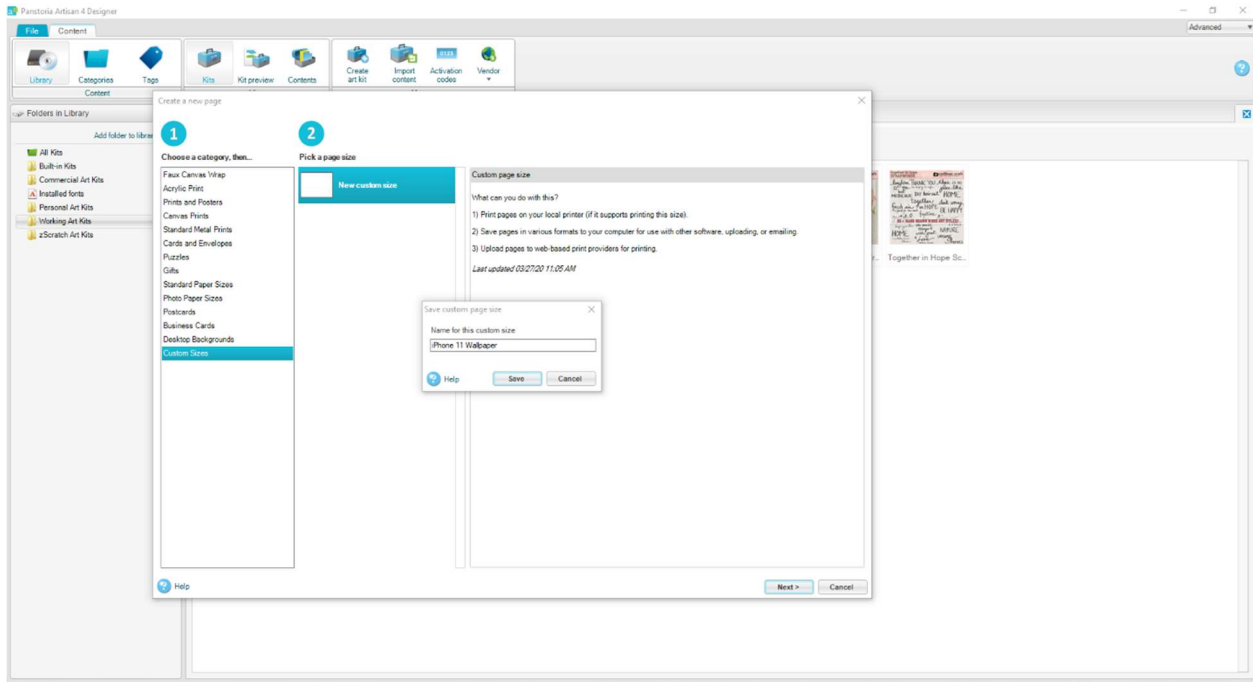

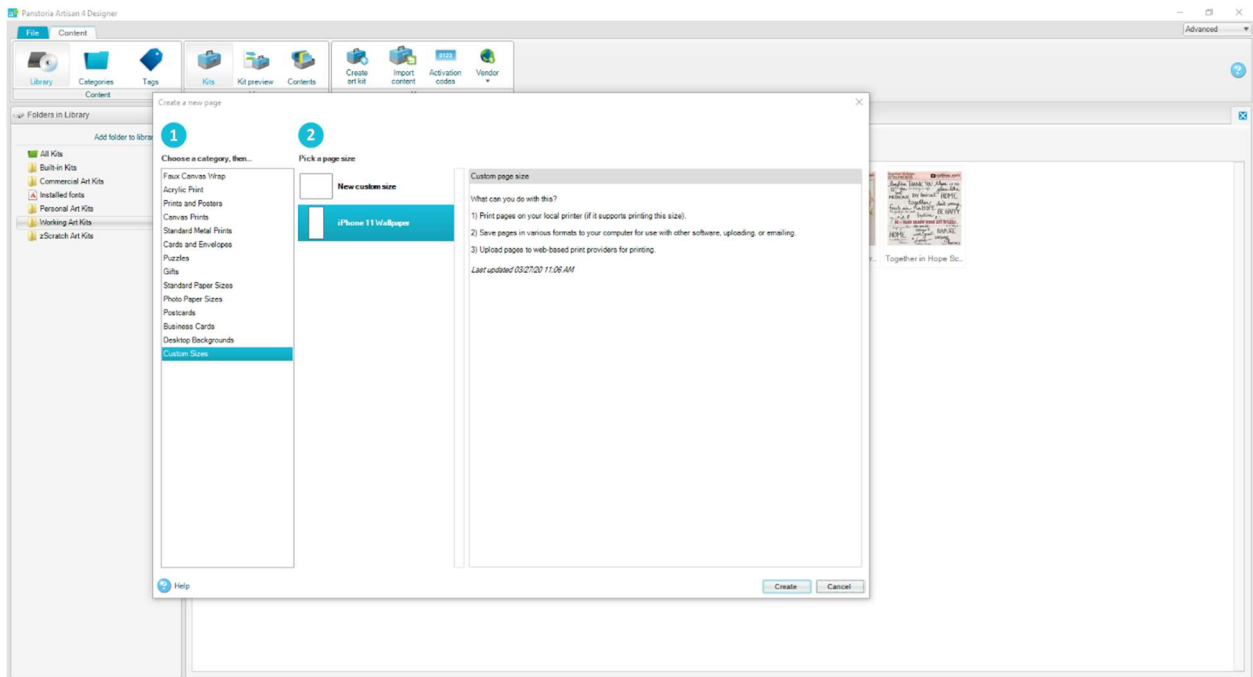

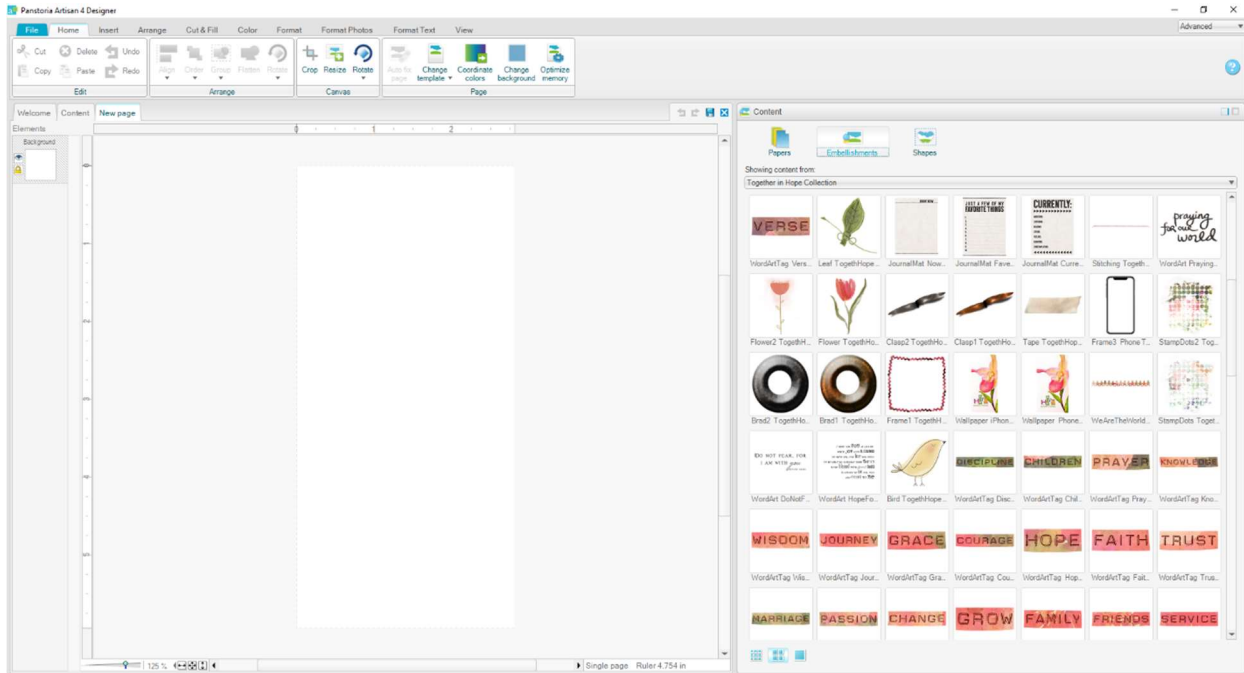
4. Enter a name for the size (for future use): example shown is "iPhone 11 Wallpaper" -> Click Save



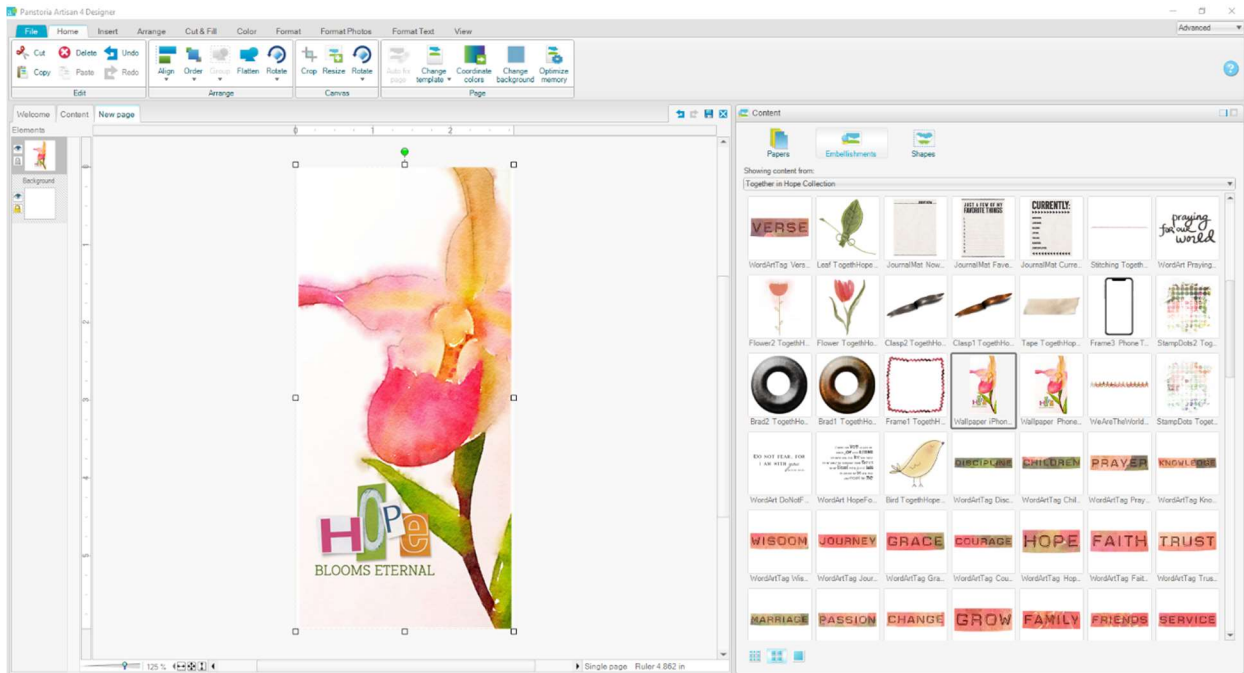
5. Pick the new custom size you just created. Example shown is "iPhone 11 Wallpaper" -> Click Create



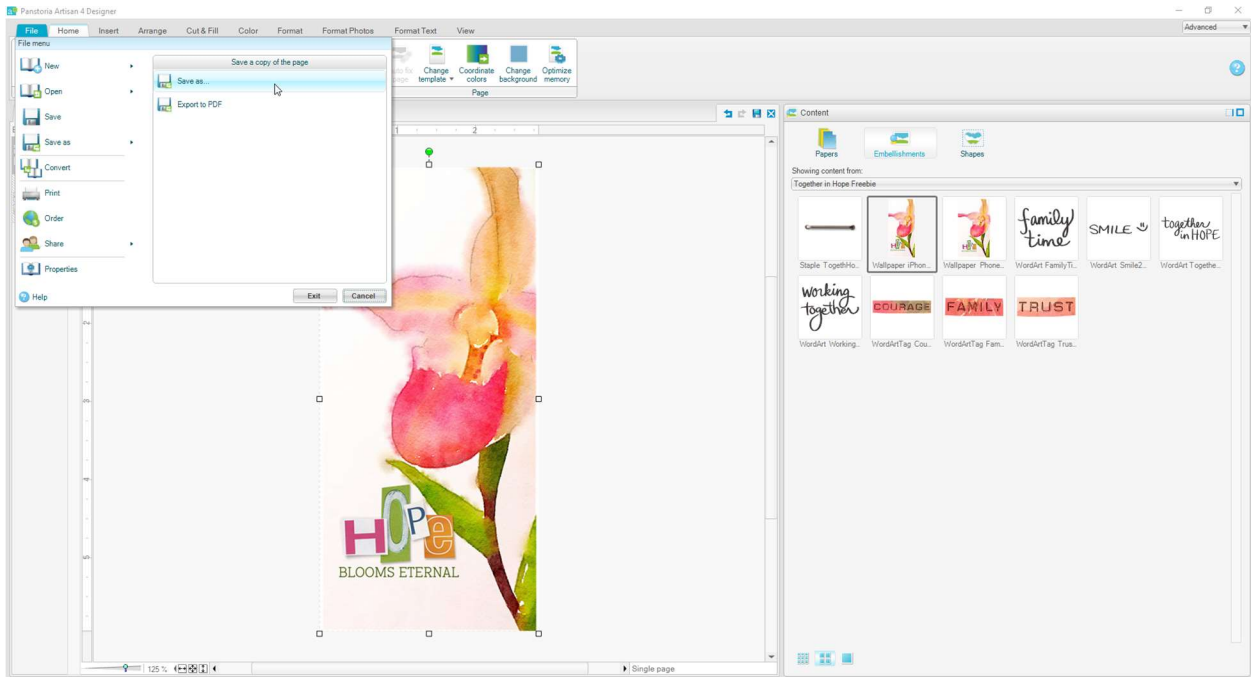
- Retrieve the content from the Artisan Kit, in this example Together in Hope Collection. Select Embellishments and double click on the Wallpaper element of choice.



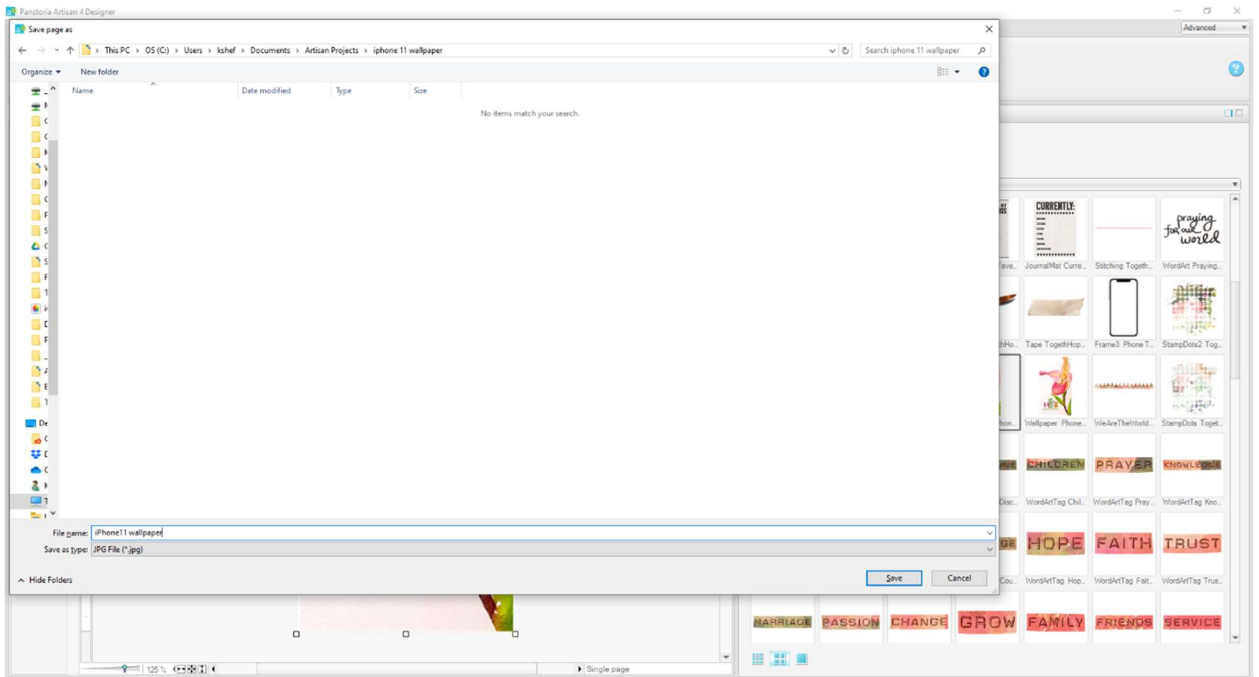
Selected element will fill the page:



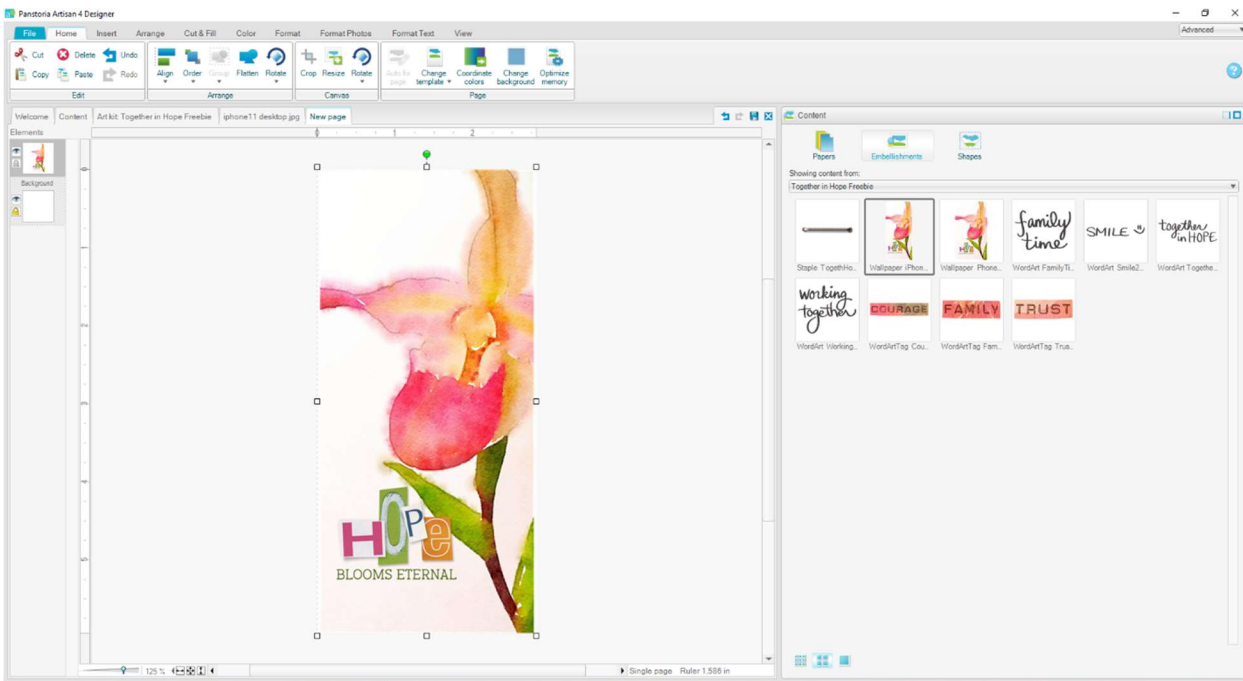
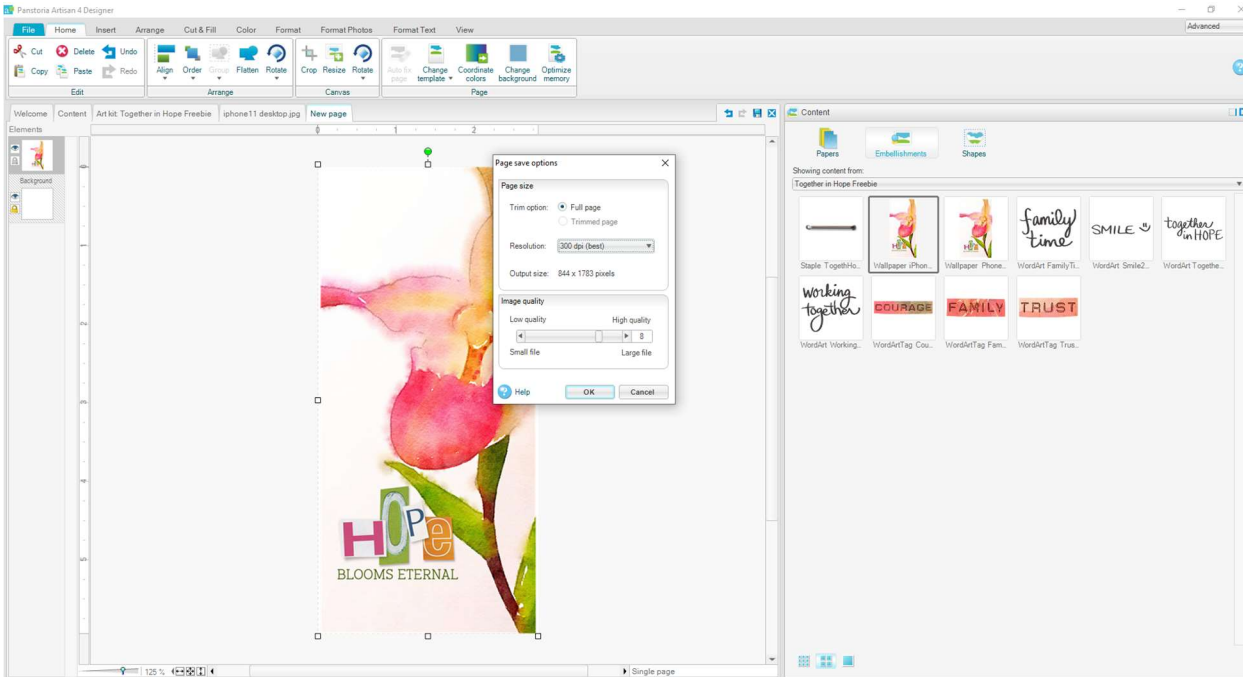
7. Save to your computer using File -> Save as



- 8. Save your file:
 - a. Select a folder on your PC.
 - b. Enter a file name.
 - c. Change the save as type to .jpg
 - d. Click Save



9. Set the Page save options:
 - a. Full Page
 - b. Set the resolution (between 96 and 300 is ok). Use 96 to get the smallest file size that will look good on your phone.
 - c. Image quality (between 8 and 12 is ok). Use 8 to get the smallest file size that will look good on your phone.
 - d. Click OK.



10. Done with Artisan. Now you can load the newly created .jpg file to your phone. We think the easiest way to do this is to send an email to yourself with the .jpg file attached. Then use your phone's email function to save the attachment to your phone and set it as wallpaper. Instructions for this will vary based on the phone model and version of IOS or Android.
